Prior to choosing your costume ask yourself if people may be offended by it. If in doubt – don't. We have created the following guidelines to ensure that everyone has the best experience possible, in and out of costume:

- **Your PASS Summit badge must be displayed at all times.**
- PASS conference staff reserve the right to ask for the removal of masks.
- No nudity or sexually explicit costumes are allowed.
- Footwear is required.
- If your costume replicates a uniform, please distinguish that it is a costume.
- Hateful symbols are not welcome at PASS Summit.
- Prop weapons/weapons are not allowed in any form.
- Conference staff reserves the right to ask you to change if your outfit is not acceptable.
